### Project Outline

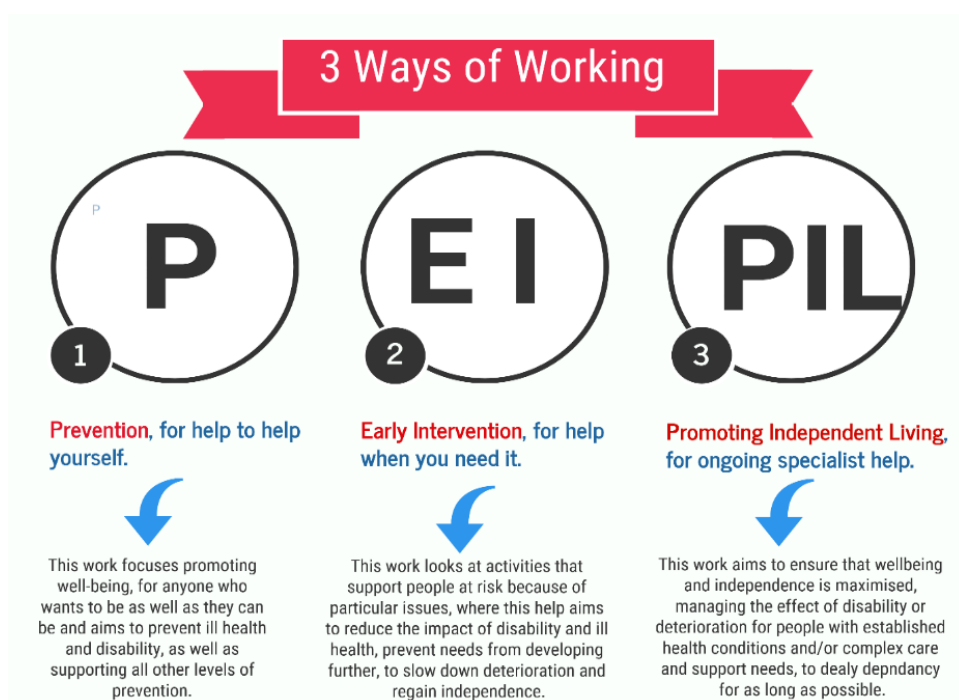
Is a third sector collaborative to reduce the impact of disability and ill health. To prevent needs from developing further, slow down deterioration, help regain independence and provide an effective route to statutory service *ONLY* when they are needed.

CUSP targets people at risk of losing independence through poor health or increasing frailty, to halt or slow down any deterioration and actively seek to improve their situation through community based solutions and is a tier 2 preventative service to reduce the impact of disability or ill health.

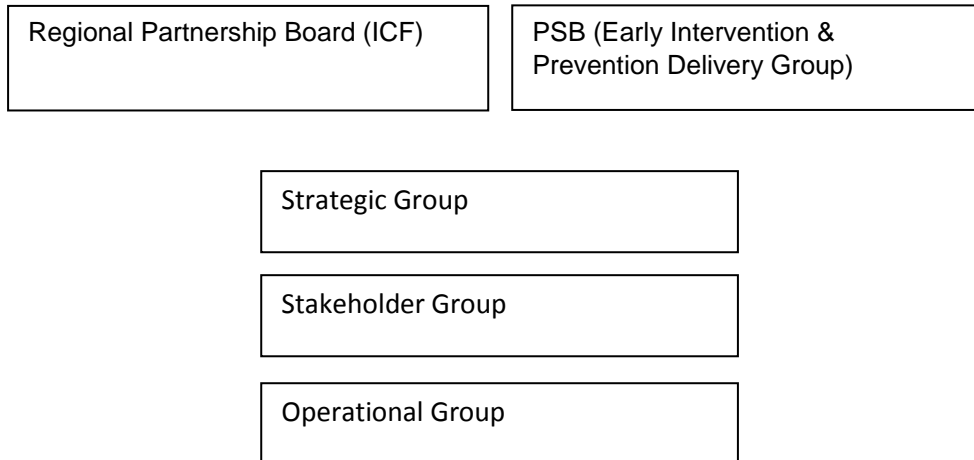
The project aims to connect individuals back to their community and provide practical solutions that support & maximise independence.

- Reducing inequalities and promoting inclusion
- Preventing or delaying frailty and dependence
- Reducing the number of older people who are accessing support in crisis
- Enabling people to take responsibility to maintain their own health and wellbeing
- Ensuring effective and appropriate access to statutory assessment, care and support

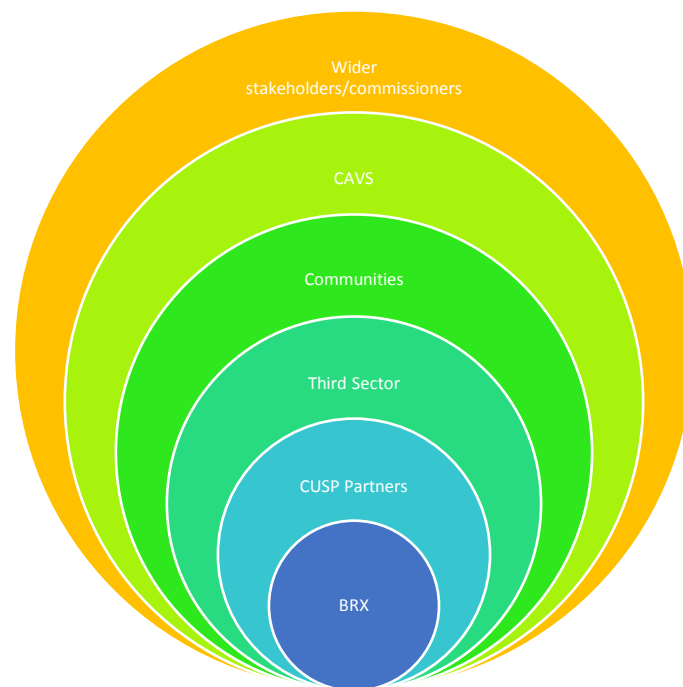
