GUIDANCE NOTES

These notes are designed to give a brief outline of the criteria the panel will be using when reading the completed nomination forms.

CATEGORY

- ADULT VOLUNTEER (Over 25)
- YOUNG VOLUNTEER (Under 25)

An individual who has carried out a volunteering activity which has contributed significantly to the development of their organisation and/or has had a positive impact on the community and the quality of life of residents in Carmarthenshire.

CATEGORY

TRUSTEE in memory of Dr. Christopher Reed MBE

An individual who has acted as a trustee and contributed significantly to the development of their organisation.

CATEGORY

- GROUP

An organisation that has contributed and made a positive impact to the community and individuals in Carmarthenshire. Must have two or more individuals, whether as an *informal group* or a *formally constituted organisation* within the county of Carmarthenshire.

CATEGORY

- RURAL VOLUNTEER (supported by LEADER)

An individual or group, who's volunteering activity takes place in a rural setting, which makes a significant contribution to the wellbeing of their own community.

CATEGORY

- SPECIAL RECOGNITION

An individual who, in the judges' view, meets the above criteria and goes beyond that to make an outstanding contribution not only to the organisation that they volunteer with but their community as a whole. You should be as precise as possible and give examples where appropriate.

Long service is NOT ENOUGH on its own to merit an award.

1. Nominations must be received by Tuesday August 10th 2019 at CAVS, The Mount, 18 Queen Street, Carmarthen SA31 1JT, using this form or a photocopied version. Or emailing the form to admin@cavs.org.uk
2. Nominees must be living and volunteering in Carmarthenshire for the past 12 months.
3. Permission must be sought from the nominee.
4. No more than **2 volunteers** can be nominated from one organisation.
5. Winners of the awards will be contacted by CAVS and invited to attend an Awards Ceremony. Photographs and information regarding their volunteering may be used for publicity purposes.
6. An independent panel of judges consisting of representatives from CAVS Volunteer Centre & CAVS Board of Trustees, representatives of CVON and the Third Sector Forum will make the final decision on winning entries.
7. Volunteers cannot be nominated by themselves or a family member.
8. Volunteers and employees working directly for CAVS projects are ineligible to apply.
9. Information gathered as a result of the CAVS Volunteer Recognition Award 2019 will be kept by CAVS in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations.
